

1. WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT AND FOR WHAT PURPOSE?

The categories of information we collect can include:

- **Information you provide to us directly.** We may collect personal information, such as your name, phone number, and e-mail address when you communicate with us. We may also collect any communications between us and any other information you provide to us and our representatives. If you place an order, you may make a payment through an electronic payment page, which may ask for billing information such as a credit card number. This collection and use of information may be conducted by the third party payment processor and subject to that third party's terms of use and privacy policy.
- **Information we receive from third parties.** From time to time, we may receive information about you from third parties, or become aware of information about you that is publicly available.

In addition to this information, we use automated systems to collect certain web site usage data. This collection and the uses of this data are described in more detail in the next section.

- **Use of information.** We use this information to operate, maintain, and provide to you the features and functionality of the Site, as well as to communicate directly with you, including to send you email messages and, in some circumstances, phone calls regarding an order. We may from time to time send promotional and marketing email communications. If you do not wish to receive such communications, you may unsubscribe by following the instructions included in each such message.

2. HOW WE USE COOKIES AND OTHER TRACKING TECHNOLOGY TO COLLECT INFORMATION.

- **Methods of collection and types of data collected.** We, and our third party partners, may automatically collect certain types of usage information when you visit our Site, read our emails, or otherwise engage with us. We typically collect this information through a variety of tracking technologies, such as cookies (collectively, "tracking technologies"). For example, we may collect information such as your IP address, browser type, Internet service provider, platform type, device type, operating system, date and time stamp, a unique ID that allows us to uniquely identify your browser, mobile device, and other such information. We also collect information about the way you use our Site, for example, the site from which you came and the site to which you are going when you leave our Site, the pages you visit, the links you click, how frequently you access the Site, whether you open emails or click the links contained in emails, and other actions you take on the Site. We

may collect analytics data, or use third-party analytics tools, to help us measure traffic and usage trends for the Site and to understand more about the demographics of our Site visitors.

- **Use of data collected.** We use or may use the data collected through tracking technologies to: (a) remember information so that you will not have to re-enter it during your visit or the next time you visit the Site; (b) provide custom, personalized content and information, including targeted content and advertising; (c) monitor aggregate metrics such as total number of visitors, traffic, usage, and demographic patterns on our Site; (d) diagnose or fix technology problems; and (e) otherwise to plan for and enhance our Site. Data collected is not used for any purpose that is not related to our own marketing and sales efforts; order fulfillment; or maintenance or improvement of our own Site.

If you would prefer not to accept cookies, most browsers will allow you to: (i) change your browser settings to notify you when you receive a cookie, which lets you choose whether or not to accept it; (ii) disable existing cookies; or (iii) set your browser to automatically reject cookies. Please note that doing so may negatively impact your experience using the Site. You may not be able to delete or block all cookies. Deleting cookies does not delete Local Storage Objects (LSOs) such as HTML5. You may also set your e-mail options to prevent the automatic downloading of images that may contain technologies that would allow us to know whether you have accessed our e-mail and performed certain functions with it.

3. SHARING OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may share your personal information in the instances described below. For further information on your choices regarding your information, see the “Control Over Your Information” section below.

We may share your personal information with:

- Third parties at your request;
- Third-party vendors and other service providers that perform services on our behalf;
- Other parties in connection with a company transaction, such as a merger, sale of company assets or shares, reorganization, financing, change of control or acquisition of all or a portion of our business by another company or third party, or in the event of a bankruptcy or related or similar proceedings; and
- Third parties as required by law or subpoena or if we reasonably believe that such action is necessary to (a) comply with the law and the reasonable requests of law enforcement; (b) to enforce our Terms of Use or to protect the security or integrity of our Site; and/or (c) to exercise or protect the rights, property, or personal safety of Company, our visitors, or others.

We may also share information with others in an aggregated or otherwise anonymized form that does not reasonably identify you directly as an individual.

4. CONTROL OVER YOUR INFORMATION

5. HOW WE STORE AND PROTECT YOUR INFORMATION

Data storage and transfer: Your information collected through our website may be stored and processed in the United States or any other country in which Company or its service providers maintain facilities.
